KINDNESS POLICY

We teach our awasisak to be kind and to treat everyone with respect. We expect this from them, and from each other. In the spirit of wâhkôhtowin (kinship, family), please show kindness and respect when talking to our staff.

We will not allow any kind of abuse.

END OF DAY

This year, we have new rules for endof-day pickups to make sure our awasisak get home safely. Any changes for pickup or buses must be called in **before 2:45 PM**. We cannot promise to make changes after that time.

Please do not come to pick up your child between 3:00 and 3:10 PM. This is our busiest time as we get students ready to go home, and we need to keep the halls clear for safety. You may be asked to wait until students are brought to the front. Ay-hay for your cooperation!

IMPORTANT NOTES & POLICIES

HUG-AND-GO

To help keep our school safe, we are asking families to follow our hug-and-go policy. This means goodbyes will happen in the front area, and one of our caring staff will walk your awasis to class to make sure they arrive safe and sound.

We know that saying goodbye can sometimes feel hard—for both students and caregivers. If you'd like some extra support with these transitions, our school counsellor is here to help.

FOOD & SNACKS

MESC has a wonderful food program that gives all students healthy and tasty meals and snacks. Each student also has a water bottle in their classroom. You do not need to send extra food for your awasis.



If you do choose to send snacks or lunch, please remember we are a **peanut-free school** because of serious allergies.

We also ask that you send healthy choices, so the awasisak have the energy they need to play and learn. Watch for some helpful ideas on healthy foods coming next month!



SCHOOL SUPPLIES


Most of the supplies your awasis needs for learning are provided by the school. There are just a few things we ask you to send:

- Indoor shoes please label them clearly.
- A backpack also labelled clearly.
- An extra set of clothes (socks, underwear, bottoms, and a top) to keep in the backpack in case they are needed.
- If your awasis wears pull-ups, please send all supplies for changing, as we do not carry these at school.

SUPPORTS AVAILABLE

We are very lucky to have many supports at our school to help our awasisak. Along with our wonderful teachers and EAs, we also have a school counsellor. She helps students in many different ways, and an introduction to her and her services will be sent home in the next couple of weeks.

We also offer extra support services when needed, such as speech and language, occupational therapy, and learning support. If you have any questions or concerns, please reach out—we are happy to share more.




